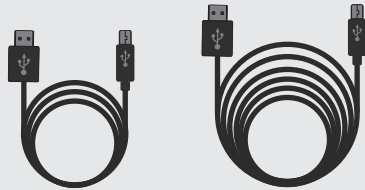

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Konftel Reach includes two active optical USB cables, 5 and 15 meters long. Take precautions during installation in order to avoid damages to the cables. For optimal performance it's important to **connect both of them**. Depending on where the Konftel OCC hub and Konftel camera is located in the room you choose which cable to connect where.

HOW TO INSTALL

Step 1: Connect both cables to the Konftel OCC Hub

Connect both of the cables to the hub and the camera, as shown in the image to the right. It doesn't matter which cable you connect to the camera or to the laptop as long as you connect them both.

Step 2: Update Konftel OCC Hub

Update the firmware of Konftel OCC Hub.

Step 3: Update Konftel 800 and Konftel Cam20

If you have a Konftel Cam20 or/and a Konftel 800 you will need to upgrade them as well.
